

A Day of Action to End Violence Against Women Living With HIV

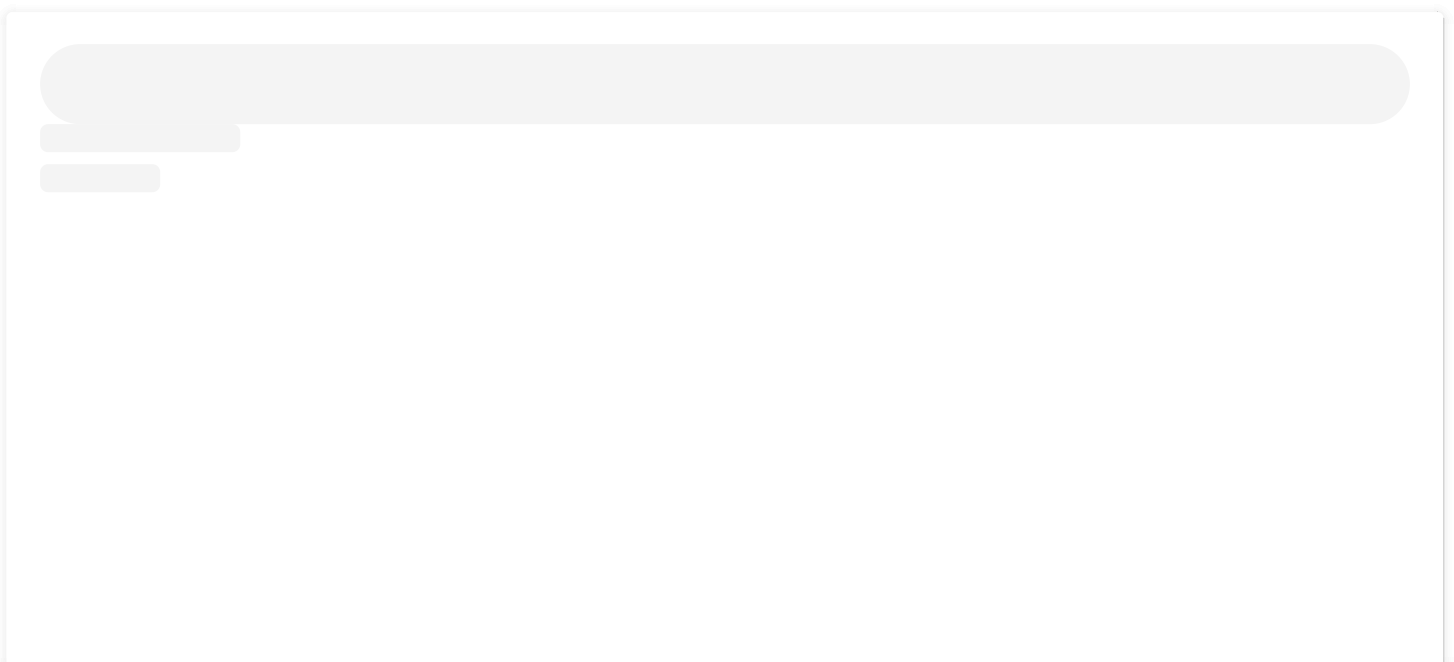
Positive Women's Network-USA hosts several October events to raise awareness of intimate partner violence and women living with HIV.

In recognition of [Intimate Partner Violence Awareness Month](#) observed annually in October, the [Positive Women's Network-USA \(PWN\)](#) is hosting several events that aim to uplift women living with and affected by HIV.

PWN-USA is a trans-inclusive national nonprofit group of women living with [HIV](#). In October 2014, the nonprofit spearheaded the first National Day of Action to End Violence Against Women Living with HIV to draw attention to high rates of interpersonal [violence](#), abuse and systemic brutality experienced by women living with HIV.

Throughout October, local PWN chapters are offering in-person and virtual events to highlight the impact of intimate partner violence and the complications associated with disclosing one's HIV-positive status.
