

Housing Works' Fashion for Action Raised \$250K for HIV Services

The event sold hundreds of discounted designer items in support of low-income and homeless New Yorkers living with or affected by HIV.

In an act of retail activism, the highly anticipated Housing Works Fashion for Action fundraiser collected \$250,000 to support the [HIV](#) nonprofit's mission.

The fashion-forward [fundraiser](#) kicked off on November 12 with a VIP opening night reception and sale featuring discounted apparel and accessories from over 80 brands and a dozen curators.

The shopping extravaganza took place at the Housing Works flagship thrift shop in New York City's Chelsea neighborhood. The event was open to the public from November 13 through 15.



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Launched in 1990, [Housing Works](#) has grown to serve more than 30,000 low-income and homeless [New Yorkers](#), most of whom are living with or affected by HIV and [AIDS](#). Fashion for Action, Housing Works' signature fashion fundraiser, has raised over \$10 million total for the nonprofit's mission.

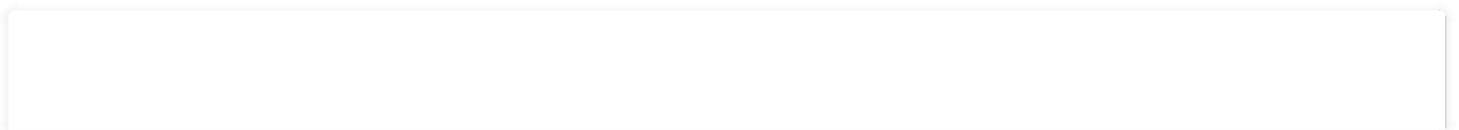
