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Hepatitis viruses and liver diseases strike millions of people in the United States every year, including a disproportionate number of Latinos.

Among all ethnic groups, Latinos have some of the highest risks of contracting, being diagnosed with or dying from hepatitis A and B viruses. In addition, they have a higher prevalence of hepatitis C compared with the general population.

Don't think you're at risk? If you've ever had unprotected sex or used drugs, keep reading.
